During this process, I spent time experimenting with different prompts to see how they would influence the tone and direction of my resume. I tried to be as clear as possible when explaining what industries I wanted the resumes tailored toward. I also made sure to describe the type of language I wanted the AI to use, such as more customer focused wording for marketing or a calmer and more patient tone for healthcare. Giving the AI this context made the rewritten versions feel more intentional and aligned with what employers in those fields typically look for.

When I compared the Allegenerated resumes to my original one, I noticed how much the wording changed. The descriptions sounded more confident and polished, and they emphasized skills that were more relevant to each role. My actual experience stayed the same, but the way it was presented made a big difference in how professional it sounded.

Overall, this showed me that prompt engineering really comes down to being specific and clear. When you tell the AI exactly who the audience is and how you want to present yourself, the writing becomes much more natural, focused, and effective.
